2016 Key Facts

- Kingdom Culture “Gathering of Nations” started in Groves, Texas in 2008, by Pastor Tyron Hanks, a Pastor to the People. In 2016 Kingdom Culture had the honor of being held at Greater Malabar Christian Center in Arima, Trinidad. It continues to grow and develop new national and international partnerships to help empower and sustain a myriad of underdeveloped communities
- Proceeds raised in fiscal year 2015-2016 totaled \$10,000 U.S. Dollars (\$66,945 TTD) and went towards the following Trinidad and Tobago foundation: [Malabar Transitional of Hope](#) (Transitional Housing & Social Services)
- **What progress has been made since the funding was given?**
Construction has begun for up to 3 houses that will host up to 30 individuals who are homeless. Participants will also receive various social services free of charge to help them go from humans “being” to humans “becoming”.
- **Any special guest known to Trinidad & Tobago?** Bishop Jankee Raghunanan – Local Government Counselor, Merlyn J. Calliste – Counselor of Arima South, Alderman Bert Pollidere and Ancil Antoine – Honorable Brigadier General (Retired) Member of Parliament for D'abadie/ O'Meara and Minister of Public Utilities
- **How many participants were there in 2016?** Over 600 people from across the globe participated in Kingdom Culture last year.
- **What will this year's funding be focused towards?** In 2017, the funding raised will continue to be laser focused on supporting the Malabar Transitional of Hope, which covers a multitude of services for locals including housing accommodation's, anger and domestic violence counseling from a Christian perspective and classes on building an economically sustainable future for themselves and their families.

To exemplify the culture of the Kingdom of God that transcends our own micro-cultures.

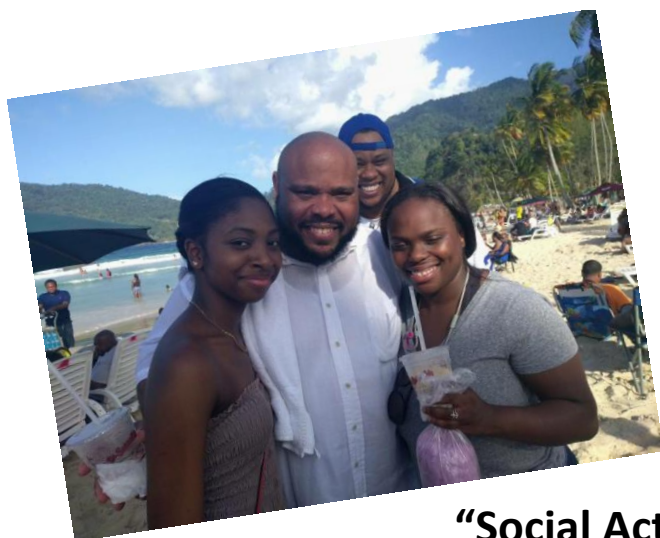
Our Mission
